PLEASE ENSURE MAXIMUM LENGTH IS LESS THAN 1.5 METRES OR  
MATERIAL CANNOT BE COLLECTED

## WE WILL REMOVE:

- ✓ **OLD FURNITURE**
- ✓ **TIMBER**
- ✓ **GENERAL RUBBISH (not foodstuff)**
- ✓ **WHITE GOODS AND OTHER SCRAP METAL**  
The white goods and other scrap metal should be stacked separately, so this material can be recycled. **White goods should have doors removed or sealed, so children do not get trapped.**
- ✓ **GREEN WASTE**
  - please stack material neatly so that it can be accessed by the loader
  - The maximum length of material **should not exceed 1.5 metres** or it may not be able to be loaded and will be left behind
  - Material greater than 25 centimetres in diameter should be cut into lengths of 0.5 metres
  - Please place loose material eg. Weeds, leaves **in cardboard boxes, paper bags**

- X** **NO BUILDING MATERIAL**  
BRICKS, SAND, CONCRETE, TILES, GYPROCK, HARDIFLEX,  
SUPERSIX FENCING, ETC.
- X** **NO MOTOR VEHICLE PARTS**  
CAR BODIES, ENGINES, TYRES, DOORS ETC.
- X** **NO ASBESTOS CEMENT PRODUCTS**
- X** **NO FOODSTUFF OR HOUSEHOLD WASTE**
- X** **NO GLASS**
- X** **NO CHEMICALS, PAINTS, OIL ETC.**
- X** **NO COMMERCIAL BUSINESS WASTE**

## PLEASE PLACE RUBBISH NEATLY ON VERGE

**Do Not** Create A Hazard

**Do Not** Obstruct Footpaths Or Driveways And Ensure A Clear Line Of Sight For Neighbours Exiting Their Driveways Is Maintained

**Do Not** Stack Material On Top Of Sprinklers And Water Meters

**Do Not** Stack Material Against Walls Or Fences

**Do Not** Leave Material on the Verge That Is Not For Collection as The Shire Will Not Accept Responsibility For Items Lost During The Verge Collections.
