



The Colocation Project is approximately 70% finished, with most outdoor construction work now completed.

In the past month, the primary focus has been on internal fit out and painting. Both of these are all but complete and internal clean up has started. Barbeque equipment and a drinking fountain are installed and will be commissioned closer to the opening of the facility.



The focus in the next month moves to the outdoor areas. We anticipate that fencing around the Tennis Courts will commence soon, however work won't be completed until the courts are surfaced. Surfacing can only be undertaken once the weather warms up, to ensure a high enough ground temperature is reached to allow for laying the surface. We are hoping this will be in September. All other fencing should be completed this coming month.

Outdoor paving and balustrade installation on paths and ramps are nearing completion. The balustrades are an important feature in making the new centre as accessible and as inclusive as possible.
