

Wongan Hills Wildflower Mural

Pink Poker

(*Grevillea petrophiloides*)

The Pink Pokers are Wongan-Ballidu's official floral emblem. These cheerful flowers can be spotted throughout the area, generally flowering from March to December.

Wells' Dampiera

(*Dampiera wellsiana*)

Lilac flowers that flower from July to October. Found at Reynoldson Reserve and Christmas Rock.

Yellow Featherflower

(*Verticordia chrysantha*)

These happy flowers can be seen from July to November at Christmas Rock.

Painted Featherflower

(*Verticordia picta*)

Found at Reynoldson Reserve and Christmas Rock Reserve, these pink beauties flower from July to October.

Prickly Toothbrush

(*Grevillea armigera*)

Flowering all year round, these are a popular flower for nectar-loving birds.

Wongan Triggerplant

(*Stylidium coroniforme*)

Endemic to the area, this plant is currently a threatened species. Flowering from September to November.

Common Donkey Orchid

(*Diuris refracta*)

Flowering August to September Donkey Orchids as well as many other orchids can be found in the area.

Short-beaked Echidna

(*Tachyglossus aculeatus*)

Common throughout the area, dig marks can indicate recent activity in an area.

Red-capped Robin

(*Petroica goodenovii*)

The vibrant red of this Robin can be spotted at sites including Reynoldson Reserve and Gathercole Reserve.

Thorny Devil

(*Moloch horridus*)

These iconic lizards can be seen throughout the area including at Mount Matilda and Dingo Rock.



Can you spot all 4 hidden Bees?

Bees play a crucial role in the ecosystem, acting as key pollinators for many plants. While the honey bee may be the most well-known bee, there are many different types. Hidden in the mural are four different types of native bee that can be found in the area.

- 1 **Red-eyed Bee** (*Megachile aurifrons*)
- 2 **Violaceous Masked Bee** (*Hylaeus violaceus*)
- 3 **Waroona Cuckoo Bee** (*Thyreus waroonensis*)
- 4 **Blue-banded Bee** (*Amegilla chlorocyanea*)
