What's New in the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu?

BUDGET ADOPTED BY COUNCIL

Last Wednesday, at a Special Meeting of Council, Council adopted the 2022/2023 Budget. The Budget reflects the community outcomes as detailed in the Shire's Strategic Community Plan. Council is committed to providing a high-level of service delivery and there is a range of initiatives implemented to ensure the continued support of our community. An extensive capital works program has been adopted, with over \$8m in capital expenditure projects included in the budget. With rising inflation costs, a priority was to reduce financial pressure on ratepayers, and this has been demonstrated by the decision to increase rates by only 3%, which is less than half of the current inflation rate.
