
Also fond of travelling and seeing more of Australia, Kim recently enjoyed a road trip travelling the South West checking out the best of the west.

The Peter MacLean Award is presented on an annual basis to any employee of a CCAWA member who has performed above and beyond the call of duty in providing excellence in customer service.


