Under Section 17 & 18 of the Bush Fires Act 1954, the restricted and prohibited burning periods are set by the DFES Commissioner for each Local Government area.

RESTRICTED: 13 OCT 23 - 14 NOV 23 PROHIBITED: 15 NOV 23 - 13 FEB 24 RESTRICTED: 14 FEB 24 - 31 MAR 24

Please note as of 13th October 2023, restricted burning will be in place. All firebreaks need to be completed by this date and we encourage all landholders to carry out any burning before the restricted period begins. A permit will be required from your local Fire Control Officer after the 13th October for any burning.
