RATES DUE DATE REMINDER

If you elected to pay your rates via the instalment option, the second instalment is due next week, Monday 13th November.

ARE YOU A PENSIONER?

Eligible and registered ratepayers have the opportunity to either:

- claim a rebate on the rates and Emergency Services Levy; or
- defer payment of the rates and Emergency Services Levy

Eligibility

To be eligible, the ratepayer must:

- own and occupy the property as at 1 July of that financial year
- hold an eligible concession card
- be registered with the Water Corporation
