


the top.

Remember:

- Please place rubbish on the verge no earlier than ONE week ahead of collection date. Have items ready for collection by 6:00am on the advertised date. Our team will not return once a street has been cleared.
- Do not create a hazard.
- Do not obstruct footpaths or driveways and ensure neighbouring drivers have a clear sightline from their driveway.
- Do not stack material against walls or fences.
- Do not stack items on top of sprinklers and water meters.

CORELLA MANAGEMENT

West Australian Field & Game Association will be carrying out a corella cull for the management and control of corellas within our area. This management strategy is in place for pest control due to the damage and impact on social and environmental issues caused.

When:

Saturday 27th April - 9.00am to 5.00pm Sunday 28th April - 7.00am to 1.00pm

Please note Police will be in attendance and all safety measures will be in place for the shoot. West Australian Field & Game Association are an accredited organisation for the culling of corellas.

Access Restrictions:

Please be informed that the upcoming shoot event is NOT open to the public. Once the cull begins at the specified times mentioned above, there will be NO access to the pavilion and football ovals. Additionally, the reserve north of Waddington-Wongan Hills Road and at the rear of the hospital will also be restricted.

For your convenience, we have provided detailed shoot maps in the pictures below, highlighting the restricted areas. Your understanding and cooperation are greatly appreciated to assist in making it a smooth and safe event for everyone.
