EXCITING COMMUNITY UPGRADES FUNDED FOR BALLIDU!

The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu is thrilled to announce that we have successfully secured funding for two much-needed community infrastructure projects in Ballidu, thanks to the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program (LRCIP). These projects will significantly improve accessibility and facilities for both residents and visitors!

Ballidu Footpath Project:

A new footpath will be constructed between Alpha Street and Bunyip Street, providing a safer and more accessible route for pedestrians.

The footpath will cover approximately 600m² and feature both grey and red concrete.

This addition will enhance connectivity within the town, making it easier for the community to safely get around.

Ballidu Hall Carpark Project:

In addition to the footpath, the Ballidu Hall carpark will undergo a major upgrade, with 510m² of asphalt being laid to create a more durable and reliable parking area.

This improvement will benefit Hall users and accommodate larger crowds attending community events, ensuring plenty of parking space for all.

Both projects are a testament to our ongoing commitment to enhancing Ballidu's infrastructure and creating a more accessible, functional, and welcoming space for everyone. We are excited to see these upgrades come to life and look forward to the positive impact they will have on the community!

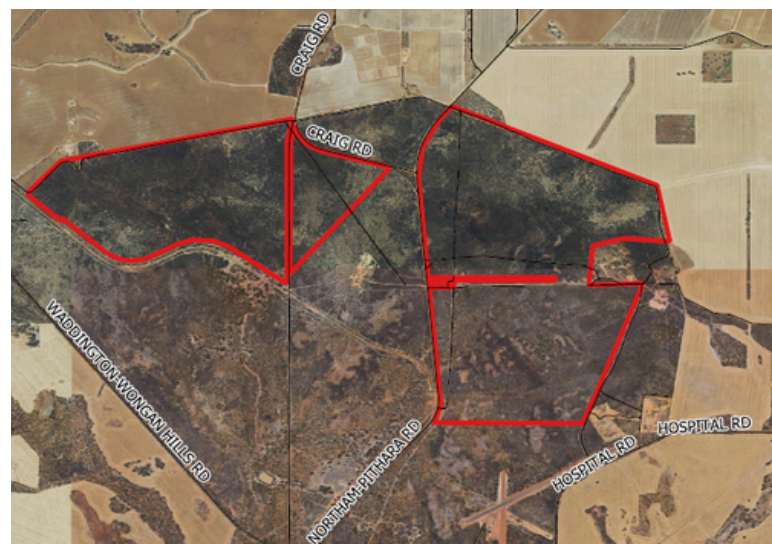

DBCA MANAGEMENT OF RABBITS IN WONGAN CONSERVATION PARK

The Department of Biodiversity Conservation and Attractions are currently undertaking rabbit control operations in Wongan Conservation Park. These works commenced Monday 10th February and are expected to run until Monday 30th June 2025. **1080 grain baits will be used** to reduce rabbit grazing on populations of Threatened plants, like the Wongan Triggerplant, **located approximately 2.5km north of Wongan townsite.**

Please look out for warning signs and ensure domestic animals, such as pet cats and dogs, do not enter Wongan Conservation Park at any time. There are many dog-friendly walking areas in and around Wongan townsite, such as the Wongan recreation ground and Christmas Rock walk trail.

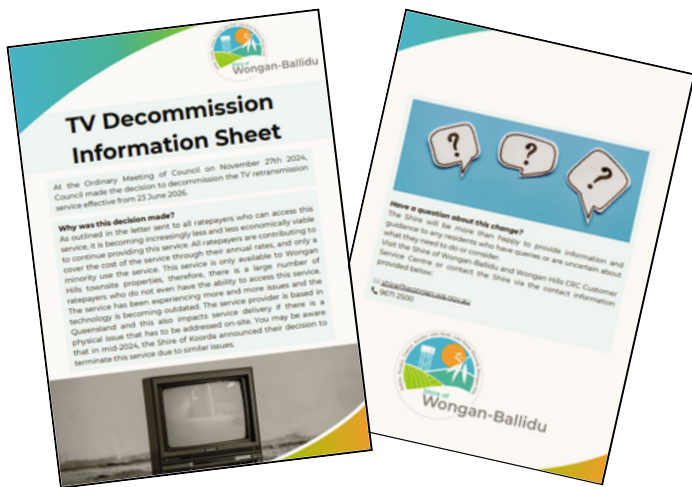
