

BULK WASTE TRAILER HIRE -

The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu reminds residents that our Bulk Waste Trailer is available for free hire as a replacement for verge-side collections in Wongan Hills and Ballidu townsites.

AVAILABLE FOR RESIDENTS!

The Shire's Strategic Community Plan outlines our commitment to leading by example in sustainability — by introducing the trailer service, we are improving recycling, reducing landfill waste, and delivering better value for ratepayers.

Key details:

- Trailer hire is free of charge for eligible residents.
- The trailer will be delivered to your property and collected after hire.
- You may load the trailer with bulk waste or green waste for the Shire to dispose of on your behalf.
- Residents may hire the trailer for up to three days at a time, with two hires per financial year allowed per eligible property.
- Waste must be correctly sorted no mixing green waste and other waste types. Fees may apply if incorrect waste is placed in the trailer.

PROTECT OUR ENVIRONMENT: DON'T SPREAD INVASIVE PESTS & WEEDS!

The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu is raising awareness about two serious problems—Caltrop Weed and the Polyphagous Shot-Hole Borer (PSHB)—and how you can help prevent their spread.

Fact sheets for both issues are now available on our website and from the Shire's Customer Service Centre. They contain helpful info on what to look out for, how to reduce the spread and how to report or control these pests.

REMEMBER: DON'T MOVE FIREWOOD!

PSHB doesn't travel far on its own, but it can be easily transported in contaminated firewood. One of the biggest risks is people unknowingly moving infected wood when they go camping. The best rule? **Buy firewood where you burn it.**



MORE UPGRADES COMING TO WONGAN-BALLIDU!

Thanks to the Visitor Centre Toilet Upgrade project coming in under budget, the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu is excited to announce that the remaining funds have been allocated to five additional community projects — all focused on improving safety, accessibility, and amenity across our district:

- Wongan Hills Sports Pavilion Façade Upgrade
 — Enhancing the appearance of our premiere sport and recreation facility.
- Wongan Hills Memorial Swimming Pool Car Park Upgrade —Improving safety and usability of the current car park for all pool visitors.
- Universal Access to the CRC with New Sliding Doors at the Entrance — Providing safe, accessible entry for all visitors — including people using wheelchairs, prams, and mobility aids.
- Community Park Accessible BBQ Replacement

 A highly valued public BBQ will be upgraded to support community gatherings and family fun.
- Wongan Hills Airstrip Linemarking Ensuring safety and compliance at our airstrip, which plays a vital role in RFDS emergency responses.

These projects are fully funded through the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program (LRCIP) by the Australian Government, with completion due by 30 June 2025.
