
### NAIDOC WEEK CELEBRATION WRAP-UP

### **MANY HAVE YOUR SAY – NAME A LANEWAY IN WONGAN HILLS**

The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu has received a request to name the laneway behind the main row of shops (from the old Westpac building to the old Newsagency) in Wongan Hills. In line with our road naming policy, we're now inviting any additional naming suggestions before a final decision is made. This process ensures we honour local history and recognise the contributions of community members, while giving everyone a fair chance to put forward a name.

### When considering names, our policy gives priority to:

- Avoiding duplication within the Shire
- ✓ Honouring Freemen of the Shire, past Shire Presidents, Chairmen of the Road Board, and Elected Members, especially those with long service
- Using the surnames of deceased community members
- Recognising former pioneers whose properties were predominantly served by nearby historic roads

If these aren't applicable, other suitable names that reflect the history and meet the guidelines.

### **MPROVING OUR COMMUNITY**

The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu has been busy delivering a range of important infrastructure projects across our region, all proudly funded by the Australian Government through the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program (LRCIP).

### Here's a snapshot of the works recently completed:

- Airstrip Line Marking
- Upgrades to all line marking at the Wongan Hills Airstrip to enhance safety and usability.
- ✓ Storm Water Drainage South of Wongan Hills
- Installation of side entry pits, 500m of pipework and kerbing. This system harvests rainwater to irrigate our ovals while improving the southern entrance to town.
- ✓ Storm Water Drainage North of Wongan Hills
- New side entry pits, 220m of pipework and kerbing. Also designed to capture rainwater for our sporting grounds and beautify the northern entrance.
- ✓ Ballidu Footpath Upgrade
- 165m of new concrete footpath installed on Federation Street, making it safer and more accessible for all pedestrians.
- ✓ Wongan Hills Swimming Pool Carpark
- Upgrades to the existing surface, with 2,230m² of fresh asphalt laid to improve parking for visitors to our much-loved pool.

These projects not only improve safety and amenity but also help sustain our local facilities and environment. Thank you to the community for your patience during these works. We look forward to seeing everyone enjoy these improved spaces!




