
The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu's 2025/26 Annual Budget is now available on our website.

At the July Ordinary Council Meeting, Council formally adopted the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu Workforce Plan 2025–2030.



## BULK WASTE TRAILER HIRE –

**AVAILABLE FOR RESIDENTS!** 

The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu reminds residents that our Bulk Waste Trailer is available for free hire as a replacement for verge-side collections in Wongan Hills and Ballidu townsites.

The Shire's Strategic Community Plan outlines our commitment to leading by example in sustainability by introducing the trailer service, we are improving recycling, reducing landfill waste, and delivering better value for ratepayers.

#### **Key details:**

- Trailer hire is free of charge for eligible residents.
- The trailer will be delivered to your property and collected after hire.
- You may load the trailer with bulk waste or green waste for the Shire to dispose of on your behalf.
- Residents may hire the trailer for up to three days at a time, with two hires per financial year allowed per eligible property.
- Waste must be correctly sorted no mixing green waste and other waste types. Fees may apply if incorrect waste is placed in the trailer.
