HAVE YOUR SAY ON THE SHIRE'S PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION PLAN

The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu is inviting community members to provide feedback through a new Public Health Action Plan Survey, now available online and in paper format from the Shire's Customer Service Centre.

The survey will help inform the development of the Shire's Public Health Action Plan, which aims to turn key public health priorities into clear and practical actions for the organisation and wider community.

The proposed actions are grouped under the four focus areas of the State Public Health Plan, Promote, Prevent, Protect and Enable, helping ensure alignment with both State and Council priorities.

Aboriginal health and wellbeing, along with equity and inclusion, will also be considered across all areas of the Action Plan.

The survey asks community members to share what matters most to them when it comes to health and wellbeing in our community. Responses will be considered alongside local population data and community planning information to help guide future priorities and decision-making.

WHEN WILL WE MEET AGAIN?

As part of National Road Safety Week 2026, we're also reminding our community of the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu's local road safety campaign, When Will We Meet Again?

Developed alongside our local emergency services, the campaign shares an important message, in small regional communities, road trauma affects all of us.

Our volunteer emergency responders are often attending crashes involving neighbours, friends, workmates and familiar faces. The campaign asks drivers to think about how they want to meet again, at community events, on the street, at sport or around town, not at the scene of a serious accident.

This Road Safety Week, we encourage everyone to take a moment before getting behind the wheel.
