The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu is inviting community members to attend an information session as part of the development of the Public Health and Wellbeing Plan 2026–2031.

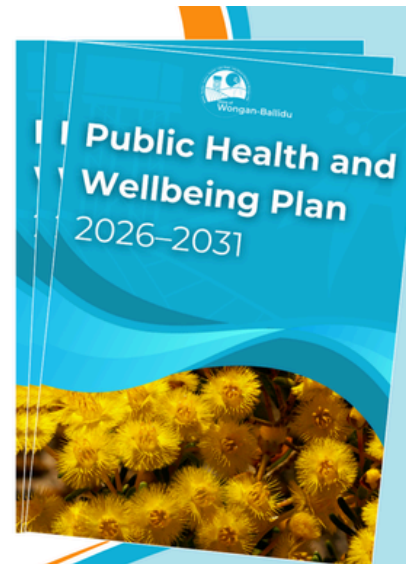
