PURPOSE OF REPORT:

To obtain Council approval for an amendment to the 2016/17 Annual Budget to allow for the expenditure in relation to paying the doctor LOCUM fees until the Medicare Public Key Infrastructure Site Certificate (PKISC) issue is resolved.

BACKGROUND:

It has been put forward by the current doctor, Dr Inoue, that the Medicare Public Key Infrastructure Site Certificate is not being issued for the Practice as a result of the previous doctor, Dr Qamar.

Because of this, Dr Inoue is unable to claim bulk billing payments through Medicare and is therefore unable to submit bulk billing to Medicare and therefore is unable to collect a significant income stream.

COMMENT:

Discussions between Medicare and the Chief Executive Officer on 25th July 2016 would appear to indicate that the non-issue of the PKISC is not as a result of Dr Qamar. However, it is not clear as to why the Site Licence has not been issued, a discussion between the Chief Executive Officer and the Medical Practice may have resolved part of the issue in relation to the Site Licence.

Dr Inoue has requested that the Shire pay him a locum fee of \$2,000 per day as compensation until the bulk billing claim system is restored. It has been made clear that this is what is required in order to retain his services at the surgery.

The Shire has approximately \$58,000 in bulk billing claims being withheld during the recent period without a current PKISC.

POLICY REQUIREMENTS:
