Tony Moss and Riley Scott of the Wongan Hills Police Station attended the meeting to report on current issues within the Shire, of which Council was most appreciative. The presentation covered the following points:

• The recent spate of burglaries appears to have ceased following the apprehension of an offender

- There is currently a group of children committing minor damage and graffiti in the Wongan Hills townsite. These youths are known to Police and measures are in place to attempt to prevent and/or mitigate damage
- The Shire has been provided with the details of the WA Police Graffiti Hotline Shire will publicise
- Installation of signage and CCTV may deter offenders
- The Wongan Hills station is part of a 3 station roster. This effectively means that Wongan Hills officers are on shift 1 weekend in 3, however while on shift they are also required to attend any offences in surrounding areas, and this can take the officers away from town for some time
- Council can write to the WA Police to request shifts and presence be reviewed
- Amphetamine use continues to be an issue in the area, as in all regional towns. Investigations are currently underway into local supply chains
