The purpose of this report for Council to resolve to defer transferring savings from electricity charges into the Medical Facilities and R4R Special Projects Reserve, commencing in in the 2018/19 financial year as per Council Policy.

BACKGROUND:

Council adopted Council policy 4-12 - Solar Panel Funding Repayment to Reserve Policy, which was to transfer the savings achieved in electricity consumption to reserve until the capital cost of the Solar panels is fully repaid.

As discussed at an informal briefing session of Councillors on 19th June 2019, It has become evident that these funds are needed in 2018/19 financial year to assist in the cost of operations of the Medical Centre.

It is therefore recommended to Council that the transfer to reserve for the 2018/19 year not proceed as planned and these savings be used to assist in the cost of operations of the medical centre.

- 6. The dogs are to be adequately confined in accordance with Section 3.1 of the Shires Dog Local Law.
- 7. Access is to be given to the Council Ranger for an annual inspection or more regularly if the Council so determines.
