Wongan Hills Sports and Community Co-Location Project



Construction and core filling to approximately 400 linear metres of retaining walls is now complete. In addition, the builder has completed waterproofing the retaining walls and backfilling of the sand pad.

Coolroom and kitchen modifications will commence next week, immediately after the last hockey game for the season. Simultaneously, construction will begin on the gymnasium and squash courts.

Work on the carpark located near the hockey oval side of the Pavillion is progressing steadily and siteworks to allow for shaping of the new carpark, drainage and lighting installation is all underway.
